Andrew RT Davies and Joel James express concerns over the plans to increase the number of Senedd Members by over 50%.

Andrew and Joel have both raised concerns in the Chamber during the Senedd Reform debate about the plans.

The £100 million estimated cost over each Senedd term is being questioned. Can it be justified in terms of helping the people of Wales?

Labour and Plaid Cymru have argued that the additional members will allow the Government to be better scrutinised. Andrew and Joel have called for a referendum so that the people of Wales can decide.

Joel said, *"I am terribly concerned that these proposals will require £100 million pounds to be found from the existing Welsh Government budget. What implications will that have on our health and education services?"*

Andrew said *"This proposal should be put to the people of Wales in a referendum. It will allow the people of Wales to have their say whether they want our money spent on more politicians or more teachers and nurses."*

ACTION NEEDED TO RESOLVE DANGEROUS CLADDING ISSUES

Andrew has called for immediate action to address the building safety crisis in Wales. He supports calls from local campaigners for a package to help leaseholders affected by defects. Climate Change Minister Julie James was scheduled to make a statement in the Senedd on 14th June but this was withdrawn.

Andrew said, "Cladding victims have been waiting many years for action. While packages have been brought forward in England, we're still waiting for comparable measures in Wales. I'll continue to work with local campaigners to call for a solution."



CONCERNS OVER MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ACROSS WALES

Joel appeared on Wales Live to discuss the failures by Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board on mental health services. Concerns have been raised regarding the trusts ability to provide appropriate care and support for those with mental health issues.

Joel said "NHS staff do a tremendous job of taking care of us, but repeated problems come when health boards fail to implement their own procedures and are not held to account by the Welsh Government. A review of the failures needs to take place and I would very much like to see the implementation of a new Mental Health Act to bring current legislation up to 21st Century standards."



JOEL JAMES VISITS RHONDDA TUNNEL

Whilst visiting the Rhondda Tunnel Joel was excited to discuss the proposals for reopening the tunnel as a tourist attraction. The tunnel which runs for 2 miles between the Rhondda and Afan valleys could be repurposed as a cycle lane. The tunnel provides a unique opportunity. It would create the longest underground cycle lane in Europe, undoubtedly bringing people to the area.



ANDREW RT DAVIES WELCOMES Y BONT FAEN REOPENING

Andrew has welcomed the news that Y Bont Faen Primary School in Cowbridge has reopened to all pupils.

Pupils were moved to Rhoose before Whitsun half term, following serious structural issues with the school's roof. Andrew has raised concerns about the state of the school buildings for several years and demanded urgent action to ensure pupils returned to school.

Andrew said, "I'm pleased pupils have now returned to Y Bont Faen. But let's be clear: this should not have happened. For years, I raised concerns about the state of the school buildings. Yet nothing was done. It's now time for the school to get the long term investment it needs."

ANGEN GWEITHREDU I DDATRYN PROBLEMAU CLADIN PERYGLUS

Mae Andrew wedi galw am weithredu ar unwaith i fynd i'r afael â'r argyfwng diogelwch adeiladau yng Nghymru. Mae'n cefnogi galwadau gan ymgyrchwyr lleol am becyn i helpu lesddalwyr sydd wedi eu heffeithio gan ddiffygion.
